William Penn. Absolute Proprietor and Governour in Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and County's Annexed.

At the Request of Philip James That I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia laid out for 40 Acres on the West Side of Skuykill to Charles Jones Purchaser of two thousand Acres, whose Right to the same the said Philip has purchased. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said forty Acres in the place where it was first laid out to the said Charles Jones and make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 31st day of the first Month 1701.
