



Whereas The Commissioners of Property by One Warrant bearing Date the fifth of May 1719 Granted Eight hundred Acres of land to be Survey'd to Dereck Johnson, And by One other War^t Dated the Twenty Eighth of August 1719. They the Said Commissioners Granted five hundred Acres More to be Survey'd to the said Derick. There was Survey'd on the Twenty fourth of June 1729. One thousand fifty Two Acres of land part of the said Quantities. This May Certifie that on the Twenty fifth of ye Same Month June. There was Survey'd to ye said Derick The remaining Two hundred forty Eight Acres. Together with One hundred fifty Two Acres by him the same Derick to be purchas'd of the Proprietary. Situate on a branch of Skulkill - In the County of Philad^a begining at a White oak a Corner of a Tract of land laid out for Lawrence Switzer thence by ye same South Twenty Degrees East One hundred and ~~twenty~~^{seventy} perches to a post. thence by Vac^t land ^{south} Seventy Degrees West four hundred perches to a post. thence by Vac^t land North Twenty Degrees West One hundred Seventy perches to a post. Thence by Vacant land four hundred perches to ye place of begining. ~~Containing~~ Containing four hundred Acres with ye usual Allowance.
