 vey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said quantity of feet,
 adjoyning to his Lott which he now liveth upon, he fenceing it in
 & building upon ye same wth in six Months after the date of
 survey and make returns thereof into the Govern^{rs} Secreta-
 ry's Office. Given at Philadelphia this 13th of ye 8th Mo^o 1684.
