



By Virtue of A Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the — Day of September 1719 Surveyed for Derick Johnson in Right of Thomas Parkhurst Cityzen and Stationer of London A Certain Tract of Land Scituate Near Bebbers Township in the County of Philadelphia. Begining at a Post in Henry funks line thence by Land of Hanse Nuse, North West Two hundred thirty Two perches, and by Vact Land thirty four perches to a Post, thence by Vact Land South West one hundred Ninety Two perches To a Spanish oak, thence by Vact Land South East Two hundred Sixty Six perches to a Post in Christian Myers Line thence by the same North East one hundred Ninety two perches to the place of begining. Containing Three hundred Acres of Land with Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. Survey'd Feb^r 19th 1719₂₀.
