At ye Request of John Jennett Purchaser of Five hundred Acres. y^t I would grant him to take up Two hundred Ninety two Acres of Land it being ye Remainder of his Purchase, in ye County of Philadel. These are to will & require thee forthw.th to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye afore mention'd County where not already taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, he seating & improveing the same w.th in One Year after ye Date of ye survey, & make Returne thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29th of ye 5th mo 1684.
