I do Certiefy y<sup>t</sup> I have Rea<sup>d</sup> Surveyd unto William John a Certain<sup>e</sup> tract of Land in ye Township of Gwynedd. beginieing at a Corner blackok. being a Corner deviding it from Evan ap Hughes Land. from thence by a Line of Marked trees North West 490 perches to a Corner post set in the ground deviding it ~~from~~ from the Reputed Land of Griffith Joanes. from thence by a Line of Marked trees & ye same with ye Reputed Land of James Petree West 47 degrees South 936 perches to a Stake Neer ~~to~~ a Whitok Marked. from thence by a Line of Marked ~~Marked~~ trees deviding from Whittpaines Township South East 490 perches to a stake set in ye ground deviding it from ye said ap Hughes Land. from thence by ye said Land and Line of Marked trees East 47 degrees ~~and~~ North 936 perches to ye place of beginieing. Containeing 2866 acres of Land & is according to ye bounds above described. Returnd into ye Generall Survey<sup>rs</sup> office at philladelphia ye 21<sup>st</sup> day of ye 10<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> Next Ensiueing*
