These are to will and require thee forth wth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto y^m on Skulkill in ye third Street so much front as may answer their Purchase. and in length equal wth ye rest of ye Lotts in ye Street, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th of ye 2d mo 1683.
