ser of Two hundred & fifty acres yt we would grant him to take up
his proportion of Land within ye Liberties of ye City & Two hundred
& fourty ^{five} ~~one~~ in ye County of Philadelphia. These are therefore
in ye Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwith to survey
or cause to be surveyed unto him yesd Land in ye Liberties & Land in
ye aforesd County where not already taken according to ye Method
of Townshipes, he seating & improving ye Land in aforesd County
& improving ye Liberty Land according to regulation and make re-
turns there of into ye Govern^{rs} Secretary's Office. Given at Philadel-
phia ye 20th 10th Mo. 1684.
