

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarie and Govern<sup>r</sup> bearing Date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of 8<sup>r</sup> 1701: for laying out unto Andreas Rudman Ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes.

There is Survey'd and laid out unto Mounse Justice Seven hundred acres of land (part of the said ten Thous<sup>d</sup> acres) Scituate on the East side of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a post by the River Schuylkil at the Corner of Richard Roads his land. Thence running by the sd Road's land North twenty degrees East One Thousand and three hundred perches to a post. Then by vacant land East South east Eighty Six perches to a post. Then south twenty Degrees Westerly by the line of the Proprietaries land One thousand two hundred and sixty perches to Schuylkil River. Then by the same on several Courses to the place of the Beginning.
