

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarie & Gov^r for laying out un-
to Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself
and several of the Swedes, bearing ^{date} the 21st day 8^r 1701.

There was Survey'd and laid out the 28th of the fifth Month 1704. unto
Mourse Jones four hundred and two acres of land. Scituate on the
East Side of Schuylkill-in the County of Philadelphia, beginning
at a post by the River Schuylkil. At the Corner of Justa Justasons
~~land North~~ land. Then by the line of the said Justa Justasons land
North twenty degrees East Eight hundred and Seventy perches to
a post, again by the said Justa Justasons land East South East
Seventy three perches to a post. Then by the line of Andreas Rud-
mans land South twenty degrees west Eight hundred Ninety and
Six perches to the Schuylkil-River. Then up the same on the Courses
there of to the Beginning.
