 thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye aforemen-  
 tiond place. Thirty foot front & twenty foot bank (the building there  
 according to my Direction) & make Returne thereof into my Secret-  
 ary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 12<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
