

unto him in y<sup>e</sup> Said Street on Skulkill Side a Lott answerable, and make returnsthereof into  
my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup>. 14<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1683.
