Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 3^d day of the 2^d month 1701. I do hereby certify that I have caused to be Resurveyed unto Sarah Delwin (late Fuller) a certain Tract of Land scituate in the County of Philadelphia formerly laid out to her in right and as part of her purchase of one thousand acres Beginning at a marked Hickery being a Corner tree belonging to John Barnes; Land, from thence by an old Line of marked trees dividing it from the said John Barnes; Land North East four hundred eighty and four perches to a stake sett in the ground by a black oak standing in the Line of Thomas Hudson's Land, from thence by that said old Line of marked trees South East one hundred twenty and eight perches to another stake sett up for a Corner, from thence South West by a Line of marked trees made new four hundred eighty and four perches to a third stake sett in the ground, from thence by an old Line of marked trees North West one hundred twenty and eight perches to the first mentioned Corner hickery, Containing three hundred eighty seven acres and thirty two perches. Resurveyed the 12th day of the 3^d month 1701, and Returned according to the above said Resurvey and bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 20th day of the 4th month 1701.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eleventh day of May 1909.
