



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners Dated the Twenty first
 Day of May 1725 Surveyed for Rowland Ellis Junr. a Tract of Land Scituate in the
 County of Philad^a. beginning at a black ^{oak} a Corner of Thomas Rutter Junr's Land thence
 by the same South West Three hundred perches to a Black oak thence by Vac^t land.
 North West One hundred and Seventy perches to a poplar Saplin Thence by Vac^t Land
 North East Three hundred perches to a White Oak Thence South East by Vac^t land
 fifty perches and the same Course by James Steel's Land One hundred and Twenty
 perches to the place of begining Containing three hundred Acres with allowance of
 Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent Surveyed Augustt the 9th 1725 $\frac{1}{2}$
