At the Request of Mary Evans that I would grant her to take up Thirty two Acres of Land within the Liberties of the City of Philadelphia, Sixteen Acres in Right of a Purchase made by John Love. and eight Acres in right of Edward Blerman, which Said twenty four Acres have already been laid out to her, and eight Acres in right of a purchase made by Amy Child, These are to require thee forthwith to Survey and Resurvey or cause to be survey'd and resurvey'd unto her the Said Tract and number of thirty two Acres within the Said Liberties, Including the before mentioned Tracts of twenty four Acres, and make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 12th day of 8^{br} 1700. ~
