At the Request of Sarah Stevenson Relict & Execut^{rix} of Thomas Stevenson late of the County of Bucks Decd. that We would Grant her to take up five Hundred Acres of Land part of five Thousand Acres the purchase of Thomas Hudson whose Attorney William Biles in his life time Granted & convey'd the Same unto William Lawrence (and others of Ffushing on Long Island) who by his Deed Poll dated ye 11th day of ye Month called June last past Granted & conveyed the said five Hundred Acres unto the said Thomas Stevenson. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said Sarah Stevenson within this Province according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of five Hundried acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our Hands and ye Seal of ye Province at Philadelphia ye 10th day of Decemb^r. A.D. 1719
