S. W. in the line of James Chivers Edward Wilbourn and John Chalfan 298 perches to a Spanish oak thence South South East in the line of Nathaniel Newlin 70 perches to a maple thence East North East 299 perches to the place of Begining. Containing 130 acres and a half. Resurveyd the 9th of the second month 1702.
