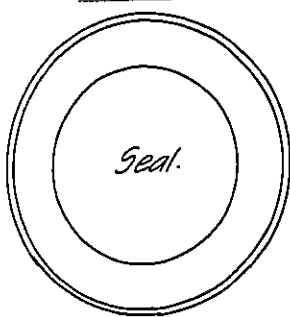


Pennsylvania

These are to Authorize and Require thee to survey and lay out to the said Susanna Cadman according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of six hundred and twenty five Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor Seated by y^e Indians. And make returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee certified by the Secretary.
