By Vertue of a General Warrant under the hands of the Commiss^{rs} of Property and the Seal of the Province bearing date the 20th day of the 3^d month 1703 for Resurveying the County of Chester. Resurveyed the 14th day of the sixth month 1703 unto Joseph Edwards of the Township of Concord in the county of Chester a Tract of Land Scituate part in the said township and in the township of Thornbury in the said County Beginning at a post in the Northern Line of Concord township at the corner of Benjamin Mendenhalls land thence extending by the said-Mendenhalls land south twenty four degrees east ninety three perches to a post. Then by the said-Mendenhalls land and the land of Nicholas Pile South Sixty Six degrees west three hundred and fifty three perches and ten foot to a post Then by J^{no} Martins land North twenty four degrees west one hundred perches to a White oak Then in the line dividing Concord and Thornbury by the land of Robert Pile North Sixty Six degrees east two hundred and fifty one perches to a post Thence extending into the township of Thornbury by the said Robert Piles land North twenty four deg. West one hundred ninety five perches to a post. then by George Pearce his land North Sixty Six deg. east ninety three perches to a post then by Richard Arnolds land South South east one hund^d and nin^{ty} five perches to a White oak Thence north sixty six degrees east fourteen perches to the beginning Containing three hundred and nineteen acres.
