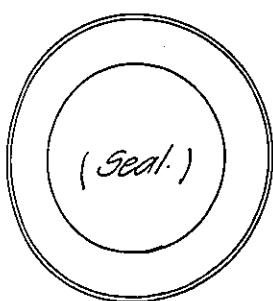


Pennsylvania

At the Request of Stephen Evans of the Township of Radnor that we would grant him a Resurvey on one hundred Acres of land joynly in one Tract with the Tract of two hundred and fifty Acres of purchased Land on which he obtained a Warr<sup>t</sup> of Resurvey in ye 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> last Which ~~is~~ said one hundred Acres of Land was first laid out to David James of Radnor at ye Yearly Rent of one penny p. acre and by the s<sup>d</sup>. David his sole Issue & Heiress Mary James sold to the said Stephen who hath agreed to purchase the Rent thereof and reduce ye same to ye common Quittrents of this Province: These are to Authorize & Require thee to Resurvey to the s<sup>d</sup> Stephen Evans the s<sup>d</sup> parcel of one hundred Acres of Land joynly in one tract with the two hundred and fifty Acres afores<sup>d</sup> on which he hath already obtained a Warr<sup>t</sup> and make Returns of both in one into the Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>ia</sup> where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain & a Copy thereof to be delv<sup>d</sup> to thee certified by ye Secry. Given under our hands at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 21<sup>st</sup> of ye 10<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1702.
