By virtue of foure severall War^{ts} from the Proprietary & Govern^{ts} dated yesterday directed to me to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto Thomas Calvert three hundred acres unto John Calvert three hundred acres unto Nathaniel Evans three hundred acres unto Margret and Elizabeth Calvert two hundred acres all upon remt in the Township next to that calloblit^d Concord in y^e County of Chester & not already taken up and according to the method appointed by the Govern^{ts} taking care to observe, alwaies, for the future, that the one Moyety Viz^t. the upper or further moyety on both sides of every Township be reserved for the purchasers not yet come into y^e Province And make me a true returne both of y^e Original field works of each Townshipp & the protracted figures thereof as also of every distinct lot and quantity of every person seated in such Townshipp, which by my pattent are to remain in my office.
