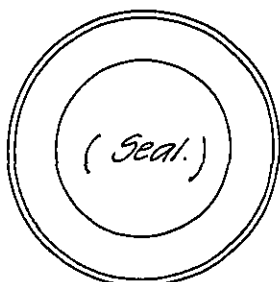


Pennsylvania

These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey the said Ellis Ellis the said two hundred and thirty Acres of Land as formerly located to and now seated by the said -Ellis and make Returns thereof into the Gen^l Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to Remain and a Copy thereof to be delved to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of this Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12^{mo} 1701.
