E. 344 perch to a marked white oak standing by Crum Cree and from thence along ^{up} the 5^d Crum Cree on several courses to a marked white oak and from thence S. W. b. W. 200 Perch to a marked chestnut tree from thence S. W. 138 Perch to the above 6^d road and along by the road S. b. E. 60 perch to the first-mentioned Powells Line P.-
