By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of John Davis of Philad<sup>a</sup> that we would Grant him to take up five  
 further  
 Hundred acres of Land in part twelve Hundred & fifty acres the original purchase of  
 William Kent made of the late Proprietary by Deeds of Lease & Release dated y<sup>e</sup>. 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>  
 dayes of October 1681 the Right whereof being now vested in the said John Davis. These  
 are therefore to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said  
 John Davis in the aforesaid Right the quantity of five Hundred acres of Land according  
 to the method of Townships appointed) that has not been already Survey'd nor appropria-  
 ted nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office  
 Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 8<sup>th</sup> day of y<sup>e</sup> 11<sup>th</sup>
