*At the Request of John Davis of Philadelphia Taylor That we would Grant him to  
Take up four Acres of Liberty Land in Right of John Stevens first Purchaser of Two Hundred  
and fifty Acres of Land in this Province whose Right the Said John Davis hath purchased  
These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said John  
Davis the said Quantity of four Acres of Land within the Liberty of the City of Philadelphia  
That is Clear of other Surveys and Glaims and make a Return thereof into the Secretarys  
Office in order to a further Confirmation Given under our hands and Seale of the Province  
at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the Sixth Month A.D. 1714.*
