Beginning at a post a Corner of Andrew Ledrah's land. thence by that & land of Christian Allowbaugh North East one hundred and forty perches to a post. thence by <sup>ye</sup> land of Isaac Clyne and Gabriel Shooler South East Three hundred and Eighty Six perches to a post. thence by <sup>ye</sup> land of Jacob Hoofman & Jacob Rieff South West one hundred and forty perches to a post. thence by land of Jacob Rieff, Vacant land & Land of Andrew Ledrah North West three hundred and Eighty Six perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Three hundred and ~~eighteen~~ <sup>nineteen</sup> Acres with the usual Allowance of Six & Cent.
