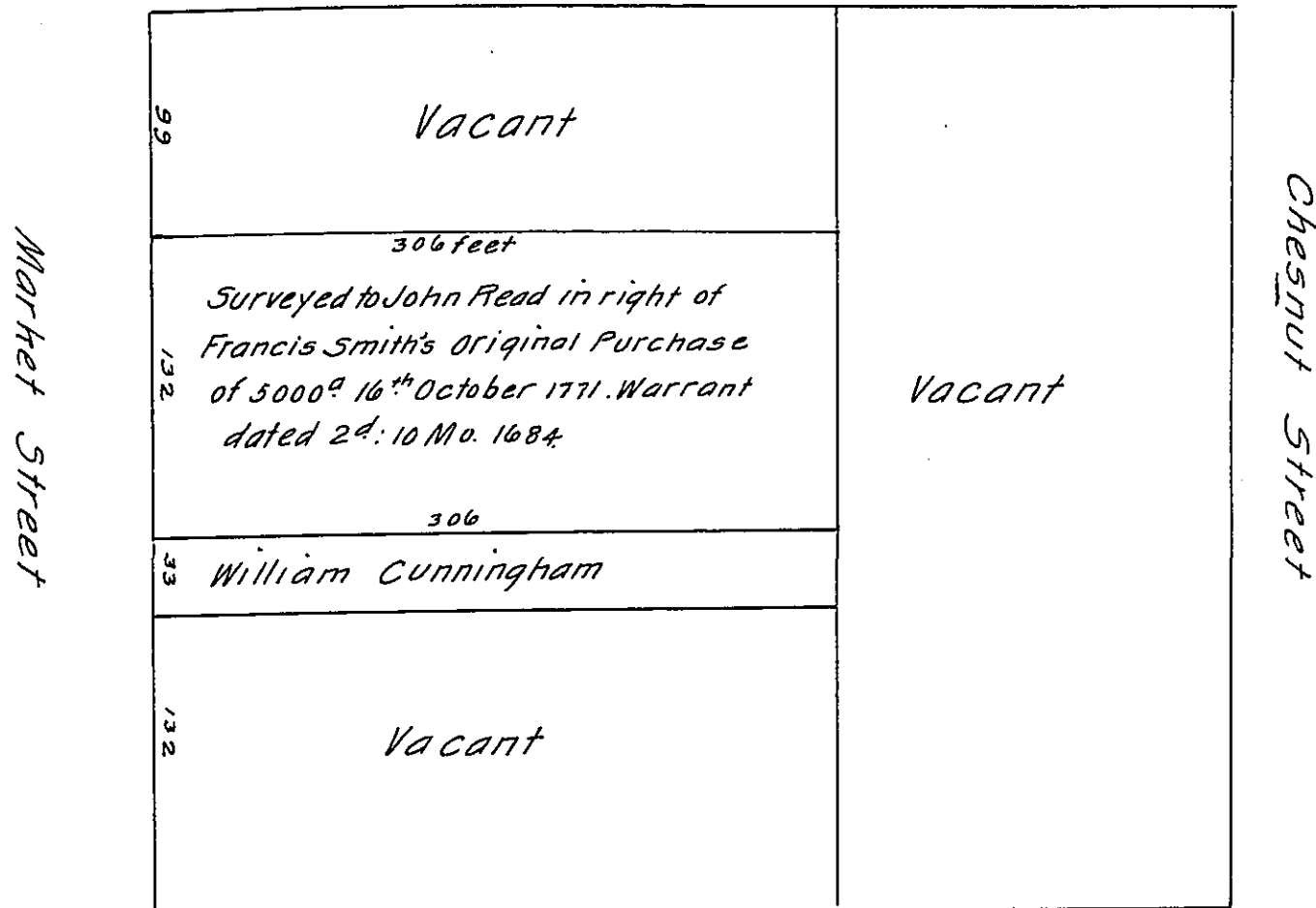


*Eighth Street from Schuylkill—*

*In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Francis Smith for his City Lots and Liberty Land under the hand of Thomas Lloyd and Robert Turner bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup>: 10<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1682. I did on the 16<sup>th</sup> of October 1771 Survey to the Representative or Assignee of said Smith the High Street Lot Appurtenant to said Smiths purchase Situate on the South side of High Street between the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets from Schuylkill. Containing in Breadth on High Street 132 feet and in Length 306 feet. bounded Northward by High Street. Westward by Ground now of William Cunningham, Southward and Eastward by Vacant Ground. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 1771.*
