



Surveyed on the Ninth day of July 1733 To Hans Snider a Certain tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Begining at a Corner post of Andrew Edge's land, thence South West by the Said Edges land one hundred sixty four perches and Vacant land Seventy Eight perches to a post, thence North West by Vacant land thirty Seven perches and by land of Rudolph Hatchlar Two hundred and Eight perches to a post in the line of the Said Rudolph Hatchlar's land, thence North East by Vacant land One hundred and Seven perches to a hickery a Corner of Mark Sheffer's land, thence the Same Course by the Said Sheffers land One <sup>hundred</sup> thirty five perches to a post, thence South East by ye sd Sheffers four perches by Jonath-an Harbin two hundred and Eight perches and by Abraham Harbin thirty three perches to the place of beginning. Containing Containing three hundred and fifty Acres with usual Allowance.
