Where as Complaint hath been made by Allen Forster, y<sup>t</sup> Hannah  
Salter hath taken out a Warrant for Surveying of ye Land she  
bought of him, and she according to contract not having satisf-  
ied him for ye said Land, petitioneth y<sup>t</sup> ye sd War (obl.) might not  
be executed. These therefore are to will & require thee to susp-  
end the Surveying of ye sd Land to her or any other she may have  
disposed of or sold it to. for y<sup>t</sup> he is not willing to part w<sup>th</sup> it now.  
Given at Philadelphia ye 11<sup>th</sup> <sup>mo</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 1683.
