 thwth to survey or cause to be survey'd for him ye Land of ye s^d Persons
 wth in ye Liberties of ye City in all one hundred & Twenty Acres, where
 not taken up, according to ye method of Townships by me appointed,
 & make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Phila-
 delphia ye 10th 6th mo. 1683.
