At ye Request of Elizabeth Shorter, y^t I would grant her to take up her Purchase Land Two hundred & fifty Acres behinde Tekony in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her ye sd Number of Acres in ye aforemention'd County & Place, provided it be not already taken up according to ye method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 11th ^{mo} 5th 1683.
