These are to require thee forthwith to survey and layout ^{denovo} ~~the same~~ or cause to be survey'd and laid out to the s^d Gunner Rambo and Peter Cock the s^d quantity of one thousand Acres in the place where they are now Seated with this Alteration from the former Survey. That one side Line standing and being continued the whole extent of ye s^d Mannor. the other may be run anew allowing a proportionable breadth and no more on the River Skuykill for the Length afores^d. And make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and Seal at Pensbury the 26th day of the 3^d Moth 1701.
