



Begining at a post by little Shickasalungo - at a Corner of Peter Gardener's Land, thence N.W. by N. by the same Land and Vacant Land 142 perches to a Black Oak, thence N. E. by E. by Vacant Land 240 perches to a white Oak, thence South E. by South by Vacant Land 142 perches to a post, thence S.W. by W. by the sd Gardener's Land 240 p^r to the place of Begining. Containing 200 acres with the usual allowance of 6 p^r. C. Survey'd 9th 5th 1720.
