



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Proprietor's Commissioner's I. Survey'd to Michael Shank and Henry Pare a Certain Tract of Land on Conestogoe - in ye County of Chester.

Begining at a Black oak Standing on the Northern Side of ye sd Creek. thence North West three Hundred & twenty perches to a Hickery. thence North East one Hundred & Sixty pches to a Hickery. thence South East three Hundred & four perches to a White oak by ye sd Conestogoe Creek. thence Down ye same five Hundred & forty perches to ye place of Begining. Contain- ing four Hundred acres with allowance of Six P.C.

Survey'd ye 24th of ye 8th 1717.
