Begining at a Post. being a Corner of John Bowens Land (formerly Anthony Yield-halls) Thence by the same Land South 156 Perches & about 4 foot to a Post. thence by 5<sup>d</sup> Gabriel Davies's Land West 212 Perches to a Post. thence North 156 Perches & 4 foot to a White Oak. Thence East by Vacant Land 212 Perches to the Place of Begining. Containing 207 Acres Part of 450 Acres with Usual Allowance. Surveyed to the said Gabriel Davies In Pursuance of a Warrant Under the hands of the Comissioners of Property & Seal of the Provinc bearing Date the first Day of Nov<sup>br</sup> Anno Dom 1718.

Surveyed at the Request Afores<sup>d</sup> on ye 26<sup>th</sup> day of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo. May 1735.
