



Jeremiah Jerman's Land in Uwchlan - in Chester County. Beginning at a Post in the line of David Lloyd. thence South East by Vacant Land one hundred and Seventy Perches to a Hickery. thence ^{North} East by Vacant Land Two Hundred Perches to a Black Oak. thence North West by Vacant Land one hundred and Seventy Perches to a Hickery in the line of the said Lloyd's Land. thence South West by the 5 (obl) Land Two Hundred Perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing Two hundred acres ^{and a half} with allowance of six P. C.

Survey'd the 28th of October 1715. by Warr^t from ye Comm^{rs} dated the 10th 11^{mo} 171⁴/₅.
