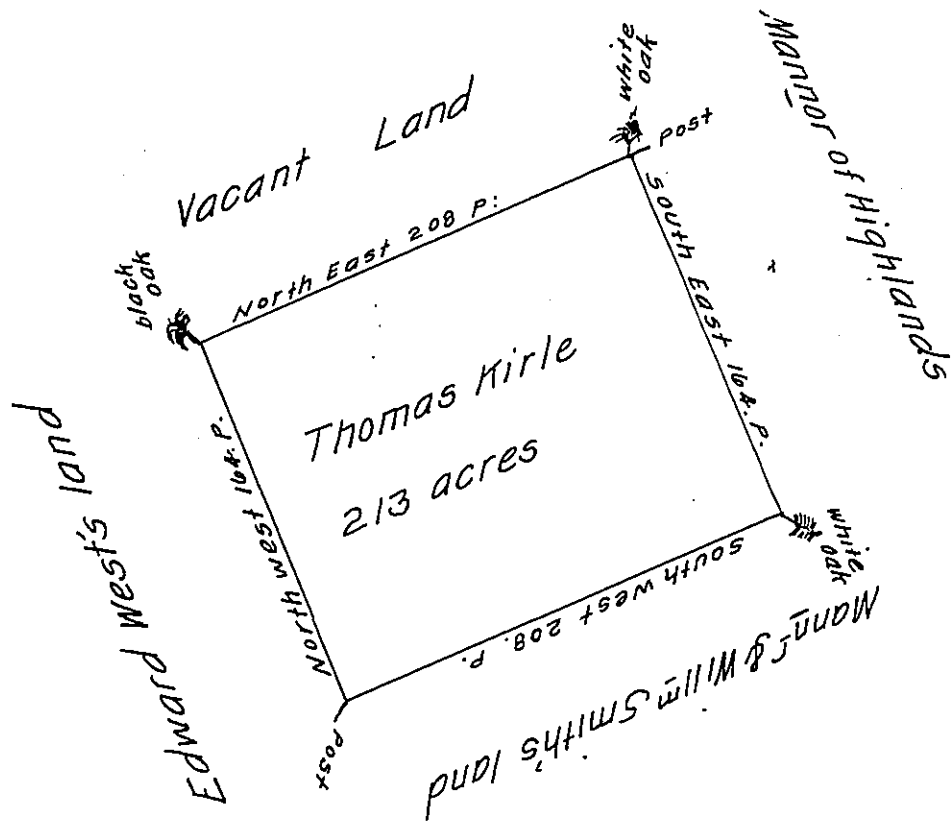


FORM NO 1.



By virtue of a Warr^t from Jacob Taylor. Survey^r Gen^l to me directed bearing date the 19th day of the 3^d month 1708. Pursuant to a Warr^t from the Comm^{rs} of Property dated the 18th of the same month; Surveyed & laid out unto Thomas Kirle a tract of land near the Mannor of Highlonds in the County of Bucks in Right of Thomas Barret. Begining at a Post in William Smith's Line being also a Corner of Edward West's land, from thence by the s^d West's Line North West one hundred sixty four perches to a black oak. Then North East by Vacant Land two hundred & Eight perches to a post by a white oak. Then by the said Man^r of Highlonds South East one hundred sixty four perches to a white oak. Then by the s^d Man^r & the s^d Smiths land South West two hundred & Eight perches to the begining. Containing two hundred & thirteen acres & thirty two perches. Laid out the 21st day of the 3^d month 1709
