



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> Mon. 1687/8. I have surveyed to Isaac Norris Esq<sup>r</sup> a Lot of Ground, appurtenant to the Original Purchase of S<sup>r</sup> John Sweetapple of 1000 A<sup>c</sup> of Land situate in the City of Philadelphia on the South Side of High Street & between the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Streets from Delaware River, containing in Breadth on the said High Street Twenty six feet & in Length Three hundred & six feet. Bounded Northward with High Street a f s<sup>d</sup> Eastward by Lot of John Reynolds. Southward by the Back Ends of Chesnut Street Lots & Westward with a Lot of Ground belonging to the Proprietary in Right of Thomas Brasey Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1759.
