



In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Howell for his City Lot on Schuylkill—proportionable to his Purchase of 500^a by the late Proprietary William Penn Esq^r bearing date the 17th 4th Month 1683. I did on the 17th day of September 1773 Survey for Richard Topliff, the Representative of the sd Howell a Lot situate on the East side of Second Street from Schuylkill, and on the North side of Mulberry Street, Containing in Breadth ~~in Breadth~~ North and South on the East side of Second Street aforesaid Sixty feet, and in Length East and West along the North side of Mulberry Street Two hundred and forty Seven feet and a half. Bounded Southward by Mulberry Street, West ward by Schuylkill Second Street, North ward and Eastward by Vacant Ground.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of May 1910.
