


Pursuant to a warrant from the former Commissioners of Property dated the 22^d. day of March 1690. There was Survey'd and Laid out on the 25th. of the ^{same} Month and year unto Several persons Certain Lotts of Ground on the Bank of Delaware River above, and near to the City Philadelphia, One of which Lotts was Appropriated to Thomas Langston and Bounded on the West with the Great Road or the front Street. Continued on the North by Francis Rawls Lott on the East by Delaware River and on the South by John Genets Lot Being in Breadth twenty five foot and in Length two hundred fifty foot.

Returned into the Secretary's Office
the 27th. of May Anno. 1718.
