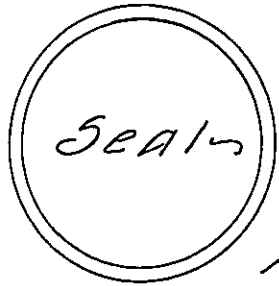


Pensilvania.

 the General Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this
 warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee
 certified by the Secretary. who is also to take a Duplicate
 of this Return into his Office. Given under our Hands and
 the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th. day of
 the 12th Moth. 1701.
