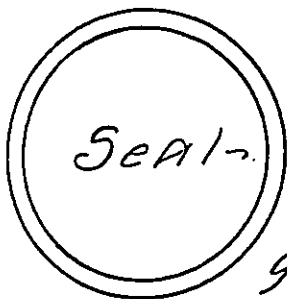


Pensilvania



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Maurice Llewellyn That we would grant him to take up ~~ten~~ ten Acres of Land within the Liberties of the City Philadelphia in right of and in full of five hundred Acres of Land originally purchased of the Proprietary. These are to require thee to survey and lay out to the said Maurice Llewellyn the said Number of ten acres of Land within the said Liberties where not already Survey'd nor taken up, and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be Delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of this Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia. the 16th day of the 12 moth 1701.
