

Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 20th of October 1716 for laying out to Anthony Lee three hundred acres of Land at Oley in the County of Philadelphia to which an Addition is made by a Second Agreement. Surveyd and Laid out unto the said Anthony Lee in the place aforesaid a Tract of Land Beginning at a Black Oak in a line of Hance Youder's Land near the bank of Manatawny Creek. Thence North West by a line of Marked trees One hundred and twenty pches to a post Then South^{west} by a Line of Trees fifty four pches to a post. Thence North West by a Line of Marked trees Eighty pches to a post Then by a Line of Marked trees North East two hundred perches to a post Then South East by a line of Marked trees Eighty perches to a post Then North East by a line of Marked trees two hundred and fifty Sixty perches to a Corner white oak Then South East by a Line of Marked trees One hundred and twenty pches to another white Oak Then South west forty perches to a white Oak at a Corner of the said Hance Youder's Land Then by the said Youder's Land on the same Course [vizt South west] three hundred and sixty six pches to the Beginning Containing four hundred Acres.
