


Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissioners of Property, dated the 20th of October 1716 Surveyed and Laid out to Anthony Lee three hundred acres of Land at Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Walnut tree ^{in a line} ~~in a line~~ of Hans Youder's Land Then by a line of trees North west One hundred and twenty pches to a Corner marked Maple Then North East by a line of marked trees four hundred pches to a Chesnut marked: Then South East by a Line of trees One hundred and twenty perches to a Corner white Oak Then South west forty perches to a white Oak at another Corner of the Said Hans Youder's land Then Continuing the Same Course [vizt South west] by the said Youders land three hundred and sixty perches to the place of Beginning Surveyed the 24th of October 1716.
