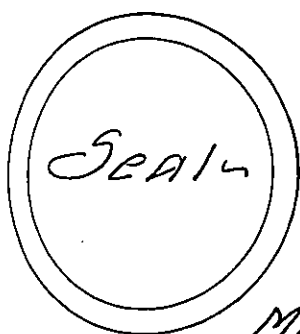


Pennsylvania }
