& Governr bearing Date ye 29th. of ye 10th Mo. 1683.  
Directed to me I here by Certifie into his Secretaryes  
office yt I have Caused to be Surveyd and set out ye 5th. of  
ye 11th. Mo<sup>e</sup> 1683. unto dno. Luff Renter a Lott in ye City of  
Philadelphia. Containing in Breadth fourty foot and in  
Length one hundred ninty Eeight foot. Bounded northward  
wth. a vacant Lott Eastward wth. Back Lotts Southward  
wth. Walnut Street Westward wth ye third Street from  
Skoolkill - and is Accordingly Entred and Recorded in  
my office, Philadelphia this 15th. of ye 5th. Mo. 1684.*
