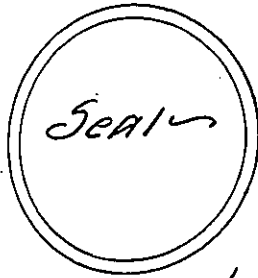


Pennsylvania s.s.



By the Commissioners of Property or Agents
to the Trustees.

In pursuance of an agreement made by us
about five years since with divers persons of
this City of Philadelphia for the better Improvement of
Several quantities of that vacant Swamp or Cripple
which lyes between the Lands of Moyamensing Wickaco
& Delaware River. These are to Authorize & require thee
to Survey unto our present Governour William Keith Esqr.
that part of the said Swamp or Cripple which lyes between
the Road as now designed to be laid out through the Same to
ye point on Delaware River over against Gloucester in West
Jersey to ye westward & the said River to ye East and between
the line of the Wickaco Meadows to ye North and ye Swamp
Granted to Andrew Hamilton to ye South. To contain Ten Acres
To hold to the said William Keith his heirs & Assignes forever
upon his paying to the Trustees of the Province Ten Shillings
Mony of the Same for every Acre thereof and ~~of one~~ of one
Shilling Sterling ~~per~~ as a yearly quitrent for ever upon
this further condition nevertheless that the said Governour
his heirs or Assignes shall within the space of seven years
next ensuing after the date hereof well & sufficiently Bank &
Dre in the said parcel of Ground intended to be hereby granted
so as to make the same fit for pasture or mowing. Given
under our hands & the lesser Seal of the Province at
Philadelphia the 20th. day of the 12th. Month (Feb) Anno
Dni. 1719.
