



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th Day of November 1768 Surveyed the 10th Day of December 1768, unto the Honorable the Proprietaries the above described Islands called the Bald Eagle Islands, situate at the lower End of the Narrows in the North East Branch of Susquehanna in the New Purchase, one of them containing Six Acres & Allowance of Six pcent another twenty Acres & the third twenty eight Acres & Allowance.
