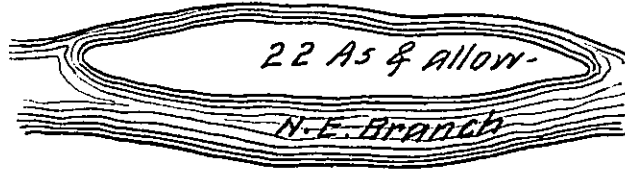


Land of William Clark
