



*By virtue of a warrant dated the 29th Day of November 1768. Surveyed the 13th Day of December 1768. unto the Honorable the Proprietaries the two Islands above described, situate in the North East Branch of Susquehanna River, three Miles above Fishing Creek in the New Purchase one of them containing thirteen Acres, the other containing fifteen Acres & allowance of Six pCent.*
